**1. Resume:**

Include all relevant information such as your education background, G.P.A., awards, prizes, publications, presentations, community/organization involvement, extracurricular activities, language proficiency and other skills.

**2. Personal Statement/Letter of Intent**

Your personal statement should include additional information about you, which the committee may consider to assess your application for this award. Such information includes, but is not limited to, your unique academic and/or non-academic accomplishments, skills, endeavors, educational and career goals, community involvement, reasons behind your goals, and any other relevant factors. (Three page limit)

**3. Transcript(s)**

Provide transcripts for academic programs you have completed and/or enrolled in presently, starting from high school.

**4. Letters of Recommendation**

You may submit up to three (3) letters of recommendation to support your application. Letters of recommendation may accompany your application or be mailed separately, sealed or open.

1. Will you be pursuing a degree or currently enrolled in a field related to public service or non-profit organization? If yes, please specify.
